**PROPOSAL OPTION #1**

Designate six hundred dollars (\$600) each fiscal year to be divided into three annual grants of \$200 each, to be awarded to successful applicants upon approval of the board.

**PROPOSAL OPTION #2**

Designate six hundred dollars (\$600) each fiscal year to be awarded to successful applicants upon approval of the board where the amount of the award is variable depending upon number of applications received, nature of project, etc.

## **Saskatchewan Club Project Fund (SCPF)**

### **Rules**

1. The Board and Executive shall have the final decision to approve or deny any requests.
2. No award shall exceed the annual budgeted amount as determined and approved by the Board.
3. Any application for funding received after September 30 of the current fiscal year shall not be accepted - that is to say, applications shall be only received from July 1 to September 30 each year.
4. Excess funding may be combined with a future year budget allocation at the discretion of the board.
5. Each year, the board will provide to the membership, the annual amount of funding available. Generally this will occur after the approval of the budget.

### **Selection Criteria**

The board and executive will refer to these guidelines when deciding which applications will be awarded funding:

- a. How many SARL members belong to the applying club
- b. How many SARL members may or may not be served by the project(s)
- c. How long have the members in (a) and (b) been sustainable SARL members
- d. How much money is the applicant contributing to the project(s)
- e. Whether the project(s) has a reasonable chance of succeeding

### **Reporting Requirements**

All successful applicants that receive money from SARL must prepare a final report including financial expenditures for the project.

Failure on the part of an applicant to provide the final report will exclude them from any future funding.
